1. The points Based Ranking System

Players earn points towards their ranking based on the four tournaments in which they play, the finishing position they achieve in the tournament.

The four tournaments are;

- 1) Selangor State closed
- 2) KL Int'l Junior Open
- 3) National Junior Championship
- 4) Malaysia (Penang) Junior Open

2. The Ranking

Per table attached, a new ranking position will be refreshed /calculated after every state closed annually. These points are agreeable annually and not brought forward to the following year.

The Selangor ranking will be updated from time to time through out the year up to the last tournament that is Penang Junior Open (being the last tournament in that respective year).

3. Aging up into a New Age Division

When a player ages into a new age Division, tournaments points earned from the younger age division are carried over into the old age division at a rate of 50% before being factored into ranking of the older division.

4. Competing in Higher Age Division

When player choose to participate in a higher age division, the points earned in the older age division are carried over into the younger age division at the rate of 200% before being factored into ranking of the younger division.
